SAN DIEGO FUTURES FOUNDATION DONATES 100 COMPUTERS TO KEEP KIDS IN TOUCH WITH DEPLOYED PARENTS OVERSEAS

Kids in Touch, the non-profit organization that gives computers to military families with a parent deployed overseas for kids to keep in touch by email, recently were the beneficiaries of 100 computers donated to them by The San Diego Futures Foundation (www.sdfutures.org). The San Diego Futures Foundation is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization created to enable a broad range of citizens cross the digital divide. Since 1999, SDFF has refurbished and distributed 14,000 computers and provided 18,000 hours of volunteer technical support to schools, community organizations, foster family programs, health and rehabilitation facilities, and youth programs.

“Kids in Touch is an important organization we are proud to support,” said Megan Graulich, Executive Director of SDFF. “Our mission is to make information technology available to the broadest possible range of San Diego residents. Through our computer donation program, many nonprofits reap the immediate benefits of improved technology, but in this case, the ultimate benefactors are the kids who can now keep in touch with their deployed parents.”

Kids in Touch founder and director Jenny Dudas said she was, “Just thrilled. Our waiting list for computers was growing and we needed this donation to catch up to the many families wanting to stay in touch with their loved ones in harm’s way.”

Dudas is planning events at Miramar and Camp Pendleton in the coming weeks as a means to distribute computers to these families. She also urges other companies and organizations that may be upgrading soon to contact her about donating their gently used equipment. Donations are tax-deductible and a very patriotic way to give something back to our military men and women serving around the world. Kids in Touch also welcomes cash donations to help pay for spare parts, cables, and shipping costs.
